

NARRATIVE FOR PATROL OFFICER DAVID IMBRIGLIO

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On 8-23-17 at 1231 hours I Ptlm. Imbriglio was dispatched to the finance department of the East Greenwich Town Hall regarding a report. Upon my arrival I met with the finance director identified as Linda Dykeman. She stated that at approx. 1210 hours on this date Laurie Perry and her husband William Perry entered the finance department of town hall. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Mrs. Dykeman left her office and went into the staff area and asked Mrs. Perry if she was here to pick up her things. She replied by stating she was. Mrs. Dykeman observed that Mrs. Perry had several documents cradled in her arm and asked to see them. Mrs. Perry stated no. Mrs. Dykeman subsequently asked Mrs. Perry to respond with her to the Town Manager's office at which time she stated they refused and then left the building. Mrs. Dykeman completed a written statement regarding the above incident and added that she would like a "no trespass order" placed against Laurie Perry from entering the finance office of the East Greenwich Town Hall. Mrs. Dykeman filled out and signed two original copies of the above mentioned order.

I then responded to police headquarters and contacted the Perry's by phone. A short time latter William and Laurie Perry responded to police headquarters. Mrs. Perry provided me with a written statement stating that at 1210 hours on this date she and her husband responded to town hall to retrieve her personal things before a meeting. She stated that several of her coworkers in the finance office knew she was there. After retrieving some of her belongings she was approached by Linda Dykeman who asked her if she was retrieving her belongings. A short time latter the Perry's left the office when they were approached by Mrs. Dykeman in the hallway. Mrs. Perry stated that Mrs. Dykeman again asked to see what she was carrying in her arms. Mrs. Perry then left the building with her husband. She added that in her lay-off notice there was nothing written on how she was supposed to retrieve her belongings and believed that she still had the opportunity to go into the office area [REDACTED]

At police headquarters I issued Mrs. Perry the above mentioned "no trespass order". It should be noted that I was advised to add "all town offices" by Captain Cirella to the property section of the form. I initialed and circled this addition. It should be noted that Mrs. Perry refused to sign this form and this was noted in the signature area. I provided Mrs. Perry with a copy of the order and one copy was held at police headquarters and scanned into this report along with the above mentioned statements and termination letter. I also placed the order in the IMC records system. Mrs. Perry also turned over several keys that she stated were to the finance office of town hall. I then turned these keys over to Captain Cirella.

X I left my desk and went out to the general staff area and asked Ms Perry if she was here to pick up her things. She said yes. I asked her if she needed a box and she said no. I noticed she had several documents in her arm and asked if I could see what she had in her arms. She said they were her documents. I asked again if I could see what she had to be sure she wasn't removing anything from finance that she shouldn't - she said they were her documents in her hand writing from her house. She and her husband started to leave the office and I asked them to go upstairs to the Town Managers office to review the items she had and they refused. Mr. Perry told his wife that she should not let me "bully" her into showing the documents. I asked again to see the documents and they left the building without allowing me to do so.

Based on the above I would like to request that the East Greenwich Police Dept issue a "no trespass" order to both Laurie and William Perry for 125 Main St, Town Hall finance office.
