NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF SUFFICIENT

ALLEGATIONS OF VIOLATIONS

The Respondent and the Complainant herein are hereby notified that:

1. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 36-14-12(c)(2), and Commission Regulation 1003(c), the Rhode Island Ethics Commission determined on April 24, 2018, that the above-captioned Complaint alleges facts regarding the timely filing of the 2016 Financial Statement and the failure to disclose on the 2016 Financial Statement that Management Resource Partners, Inc. transacted business with the Central Coventry Fire District that, if true, are sufficient to constitute a violation of the provisions of the Rhode Island Code of Ethics.

2. The Commission will conduct an investigation of the allegations contained in the Complaint regarding the timely filing of the 2016 Financial Statement and the failure to disclose on the 2016 Financial Statement that Management Resource Partners, Inc. transacted business with the Central Coventry Fire District, pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 36-14-12(c) and Commission Regulation 1004. You will be informed of further action pursuant to the requirements of the Code of Ethics.

3. Pursuant to Commission Regulation 1005, the Respondent may file an Answer with the Commission. The Respondent's Answer may, but is not required to be, completed on the Answer form included with this notice and is due within twenty (20) days of the mailing date of this document.

4. If the Respondent is represented by an attorney, the attorney must sign and file the enclosed Entry of Appearance with the Ethics Commission.

5. Pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Commission will make reasonable accommodations to furnish appropriate auxiliary aids and services when necessary to afford an individual with a disability with an equal opportunity to participate in Commission proceedings and have access to Commission documents.
